We have been awarded the contract by Caerphilly County Borough Council to construct a replacement footbridge over the Nant Cylla between Oaks End Close and Paxton Close. As you are probably aware, the existing bridge has already been closed by Caerphilly County Borough Council for safety reasons.

We propose to start work on the scheme on Monday 8th May, the works are programmed to take 8 weeks to complete and the bridge will remain closed during this time.
