## **CHANGES TO BUS SERVICES NOVEMBER 2017**

- 1 Bargoed – Deri – Pontlottyn – Rhymney – Merthyr Tydfil**
- 2 Bargoed – New Tredegar – Pontlottyn – Rhymney – Merthyr Tydfil**
- 3 Bargoed – Brithdir – Pontlottyn – Rhymney – Merthyr Tydfil**

From **12 November 2017**, there will be minor revisions to the timetable to improve reliability

### **25 Caerphilly – UHW Heath Hospital – Cardiff – Cardiff Bay**

Starting **26 November 2017**: New service to replace the section of route between Caerphilly and Cardiff previously operated by routes A & B. The frequency will be similar to that of the current A & B timetable but most journeys on Monday to Saturday will extend to/from Cardiff Bay (Wales Millennium Centre).

### **26 Blackwood – Ystrad Mynach – Caerphilly – Taff's Well – Cardiff**

From **19 November 2017**, there will be minor revisions to the timetable to improve reliability. Monday to Saturday daytime buses will not serve Tongwynlais, however there are no changes to the route on Monday to Saturday evenings or Sundays.

### **78 Merthyr Tydfil – Treharris – Nelson - Pontypridd**

From **12 November 2017**, there will be minor revisions to the timetable to improve reliability.

### **120 Caerphilly – Parc Nantgarw – Pontypridd – Porth – Tonypany - Blaencwm**

From **26 November 2017**, there will be minor revisions to the timetable to improve reliability. Following requests, on Mondays to Fridays there will be two additional journeys from Castle View (Heol y Berth) to Caerphilly departing at 0640 and 0705

### **N2 Crumlin – Treowen – Newbridge – Llanfach – High Meadow**

**From 5 November 2017**, due to on-street parking, the late evening bus will no longer operate via High Meadow. The bus will operate its normal route as far as Hill Street then finish at the bus stop on the A467 (Coed Celynen)

### **C18 Bargoed – Gilfach Estate - Bargoed**

On 8 September, the Council were given notice by Stagecoach in South Wales that they will no longer provide the daytime service on route C18 after operation on Saturday 4 November. Since then the Council has worked with other operators to provide a replacement service.

From Monday 6 November 2017 route C18 will be provided by N.A.T Group on a fully commercial basis. The timetable will be hourly with all journeys operating via Heol Fargoed. Unfortunately Hillside Park will no longer be served.

From the same date, most buses on route X38 will also be amended to serve via Gilfach Estate on journeys from Bargoed to Pontypridd. Buses will operate from Bargoed Interchange via Bargoed Town Centre, McDonnell Road, Moorland Road, Western Drive, St. Mary Street and Cross Street and re-join the existing route at Park Place to continue to Pontypridd.

The timetable of routes C18 & X38 have been designed so that buses depart Bargoed approximately 30 minutes apart.

Journeys at 1905 & 2105 will continue to be provided by Stagecoach. Passengers who buy a return ticket from N.A.T. Group earlier in the day will be able to use it on these journeys.

The Sunday service already provided by N.A.T. Group remains unchanged.

**X15 Brynmawr – Abertillery – Newbridge – Risca - Newport**

From **5 November 2017**, most journeys on Mondays to Saturday daytimes will operate 5 minutes later in both directions.

**X22 Ebbw Vale – Festival Shopping – Abertillery – Pontypridd - Cwmbran**

The extra journeys that only operate between Pontypool and Cwmbran will be withdrawn after operation on Saturday 4 November 2017. The remainder of the journeys are revised by up-to 5 minutes from **5 November 2017**.

**X38 Pontypridd – Nelson – Gelligaer - Nelson**

From **6 November**, the route of most journeys will be amended to serve Gilfach Estate on journeys from Bargoed to Pontypridd. Buses will operate from Bargoed Interchange via Bargoed Town Centre, McDonnell Road, Moorland Road, Western Drive, St. Mary Street and Cross Street and re-join the existing route at Park Place to continue to Pontypridd. The timetable is completely revised.

**X74 Crosskeys – Newbridge – Abertillery – Brynmawr – Abergavenny**

This service will be withdrawn after operation on **Tuesday 31 October 2017**.

**A Cardiff – Caerphilly – Bedwas – Graig-y-Rhacca**

From **26 November 2017**:

- This service will be split at Caerphilly with buses no longer operating to/from Cardiff.
- A separate service will be provided between Caerphilly and Cardiff numbered 25 (see Route 25 details above for more information). On most journeys passengers will need to change buses at Caerphilly. There is an exception to two journeys on Monday to Saturday mornings in that the same bus will operate route A and become route 25 at Caerphilly without passengers needing to change - these buses will show Caerphilly for Cardiff on the front. Likewise, returning from Cardiff one afternoon peak bus will operate as route 25 to Caerphilly then continue as route A without the need to change buses. Passengers can also use route 26 between Caerphilly and Cardiff.
- The 12 minute timetable between Caerphilly and Graig-y-Rhacca will remain with minor amendments to improve reliability.

**B Cardiff – Caerphilly – Abertidwr - Senghenydd**

From **26 November 2017**:

- This service will be split at Caerphilly with buses no longer operating to/from Cardiff.
- A separate service will be provided between Caerphilly and Cardiff numbered 25 (see Route 25 details above for more information). On most journeys passengers will need to change buses at Caerphilly. There is an exception to some journeys on Monday to Saturday mornings as well as most buses on Sundays in that the same bus will operate route B and become route 25 at Caerphilly without passengers needing to change - these buses will show Caerphilly for Cardiff on the front. Likewise, returning from Cardiff some afternoon peak buses and most Sunday buses will operate as route 25 to Caerphilly then continue as route B without the need to change buses. Passengers can also use route 26 between Caerphilly and Cardiff.
- The 12 minute timetable between Caerphilly and Senghenydd will remain with minor amendments to improve reliability.
- At Senghenydd, during Monday to Saturday daytimes, four buses per hour will revert to using the old turning circle however one bus per hour will continue to operate to/from Cenydd Terrace. Evening and Sunday buses will continue to serve Cenydd Terrace.

- The route of the two early morning journeys that operate through to Cardiff as route X remains unchanged but are slightly retimed to improve reliability.

**C      Caerphilly – Pen-yr-heol**

**From 26 November 2017**, on Mondays to Fridays the 0817 journey from Caerphilly and 0832 from Penyrheol will operate 2 minutes earlier.

**X      Senghenydd – Abertridwr – Castle View – UHW Heath Hospital – Cardiff**

**From 26 November 2017**, there will be minor revisions to the timetable to improve reliability.

### **Autumn/Winter Weed Control**

During the autumn/winter period of 2017/18 employees from the Parks Services section of the Communities Directorate will be undertaking a work programme entailing grubbing out, strimming, weed spraying and cleansing to footpaths, rear lanes, etc., across the county borough (this work will not include any work on unadopted highways, footpaths, lanes or private land).

Due to previously agreed savings as part of the Medium Term Financial Plan, these works will only be carried out on one occasion per ward. As you have been advised in the past, this work is in addition to the work you identify for the Community Cleansing Team. Your input into this scheme would again be appreciated as your requests will then be targeted at areas of concern in your ward.

To confirm during this autumn/winter period we aim to visit each ward on one occasion and the purpose of this letter is to notify you that one of our teams will be available to work in your ward week commencing **30<sup>th</sup> October 2017**.

It would be appreciated if you could complete the attached proforma by **Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2017** and return via e-mail so we can ensure any work required is included on the schedule. Please be mindful that the amount of work that can be undertaken is limited and could be adversely affected by inclement weather so it is essential that you prioritise your list to ensure the work of the highest priority is completed first.

If you require any further clarification regarding this matter then do not hesitate to contact Mrs. Maria John who will pass the information to the relevant Parks Area Officer who is responsible for managing the work in your ward.

## About Community and Town Councils



Community and town councils are the **grassroots** level of local governance in Wales.

There are over **735** Community and Town Councils in Wales, but not every community has a council.



Community and Town Councils **raise money through taxation** (precepts) to carry out activities and services for your community.

The job of your council is to represent the **interests of the whole community** – and to represent the interests of different parts of the community equally.



Community and town councils can use their **legal powers** to provide many services from community centres to buses. They also provide services **in partnership** with other bodies.

## Independent Review Panel

An Independent Review Panel has been set up to consider the future role of Community and Town Councils.

The review will:

- explore the potential role of local government below Local Authority councils, drawing on best practice
- define the most appropriate model(s)/structure(s) to deliver this role
- consider how these models and structures should be applied across Wales. This will include consideration of any situations in which they would not be necessary or appropriate.

The review is expected to take around a year.
