RESOLVED: Council agreed to fund up to £3k for a new boiler at the centre on the proviso that the secretary/treasurer of the club strives to obtain three quotations.

(iv) Glanynant Garden 2020/21 - bench

RESOLVED: Council agreed to fund a further bench/picnic bench at a cost of £745 at the garden on the proviso no antisocial behaviour has occurred since the installation of the new bench and that it's being used and there is a need for another.

(v) Glanynant Garden 2020/21 - Christmas Lighting

RESOLVED: The installation of a feeder pillar and lights to the tree at a cost of £1,287 plus cost of lights.

(vi) Siloh Square 2020/21 - Christmas Lighting

RESOLVED: The installation of lights on the living tree on Siloh and around the square as opposed to the purchase of a tree each year.

(vii) Poppies for 2020/21

RESOLVED: Purchase 100 lamp post poppies from RBL and source large cable ties
