- The Grange University Hospital in Llanfrechfa, Cwmbran with a 471 bed facility will open before schedule in November, thanks to Welsh Government funding, to hopefully relieve winter pressures. The new hospital will provide emergency and urgent care.

218 Ystrad Mynach Town Centre Toilets

(i) Welsh Government Guidance on providing safer toilets for public use: coronavirus. was receive, noted and discussed. Council agreed that the toilets would need to be cleansed more frequently, several times throughout the day, to prevent contamination and the potential spread of Covid-19. An estimated cost of £5k per annum for one additional cleanse was not viable, and the facility would need more than one.. **RESOLVED:** Council agreed that the public toilets remain closed for the foreseeable.

219 Gelligaer CCTV Review

RESOLVED: Council agreed that due to increased levels of anti social behaviour since Covid-19 that the surveillance cameras should remain in situ in Gelligaer as a deterrent and for evidence gathering.

220 Cycle Track/Active Travel Scheme 2020/211 - Ystrad Mynach to Penpedairheol and Cefn Hengoed

Members noted that Welsh Government have approved transport funding to deliver this active travel scheme. Details can be found on the following link and attached. <u>https://gov.wales/written-statement-active-travel-and-road-safety-funding-allocations-local-authorities-2020-21</u>

Despite the late award (as a result of the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and the unprecedented effort WG has had to make in response), Caerphilly County Borough Council (CCBC) still aim to deliver the scheme this financial year.

In relation to the land transfer delays, negotiations are ongoing and it is hopeful that both issues should be concluded soon.

Detailed scheme proposals are being prepared and will be up for public consultation in due course. Members were pleased with its progress.

221 BT Telephone Box Removal

Council received, discussed and considered either the removal of telephone boxes or adoption, due to low usage, at the following locations:

- Bryn Aggregates Ltd are seeking our view on the proposed retention of, and proposed extension to the existing quarry operations including new drainage system and settlement ponds, landscape bunds, associated works, consolidation of mineral planning permissions and an overall restoration scheme at Gelliargwellt Uchaf Farm, Gelligaer Road, Gelligaer CF82 8FY

 Closing date 8th August 2020.
 RESOLVED: Council unanimously objected to the pre planning application for the retention of, and proposed extension to the quarry at Gelliargwellt Uchaf Farm on the following grounds:
- Dust local residents are having to endure the nuisance of increased visible dust on their clothes, cars, windows of their properties and on furniture throughout the inside of their homes which is causing much distress.
- 2. Noise residents are having to endure loud noise from machinery and blasting at the site, and whilst industrial noise has controls in place, agricultural has none and it is nigh on impossible to distinguish between the two.
- 3. Environmental the development has a direct negative impact on the natural habitat. Biodiversity is reduced when existing organisms in the habitat are displaced or destroyed.

Gradual incremental planning applications have resulted in this development encroaching closer to just within 300m of people's homes. The dust, noise and environmental damage does not affect just one home but a whole estate. It contributes to considerable hidden suffering, with increased levels of stress, anxiety and depression experienced, which can lead to long term physical health conditions. The residents have a basic right to quiet enjoyment which this development does not allow.
