Important information - We've been made aware of a scam.

We've had a number of reports made to us of scams operating in the area - here's how you can check for signs of a scam:

- Check the sender's details: move the cursor over the sender's address to see who it's from;
- Look for spelling errors;
- What's the warning: fixed penalties aren't dealt with in county courts.

If you have received an email that you think is fraudulent

- Don't reply or click the links to pay

If you've made a fraudulent payment:

- Tell your bank or payment service provider as they can stop further losses.
- Check to see if suspicious payments have left your account.
