Shop lifting is quite high for March -

2 relate to Tesco 1 male arrested and the 2nd one males were stopped by security.

2 relate to Lidl – School girl attempted to steal but caught both times.2 at the Spar, both the same male stealing alcohol.

Out of the 4 criminal damage's 2 relate to the custody suite



1 is smashed window at The Royal Oak pub – known offender caught on CCTV.

1 is vehicle window smashed in car park of the rugby club.

There was 1 residential burglary at George St – happened some time over a 4-month period while house was empty.

Commercial burglary at Premier stores money, cigarettes and scratch cards stolen – 1 out of 2 offenders identified.

All 3 drug offences related to drugs found in custody suite.

Window smashed on house in Lansbury Ave – Offender cautioned for offence.

Youths damaged roof of passing car with snowball – Hengoed Ave.

2 stones thrown at address by Ex – no damage caused.

A youth was dealt with for possession of cannabis

A residential burglary on Hengoed Avenue by known offender who is on police bail.
