A drugs warrant was executed at an address in Coed yr Haf, Ystrad Mynach this month with a positive result.

A large cannabis grow was located at the rented property with over 180 plants being seized and disposed of. Unfortunately, there was no one at the property at the time but enquiries are ongoing with the property owner to identify and locate the persons responsible.



Team initiatives and Operations



The LEAD (Local Environmental Awareness on Dogs) initiative launched across Caerphilly County Borough. It is in partnership with the Blue Cross and works similarly to the ASB strike process whereby if a dog is brought to our attention by persistent dog fouling, getting out of the premises, persistent barking, low level livestock attack, we will deliver an information pack to promote and educate responsible dog ownership. They will also receive a strike letter and details/information of the dog will be stored for future reference.
