Subject: FW: Residents parking scheme - Ystrad Mynach - UPDATE

Dear All

Due to the ever-increasing pressures on on-street parking, a Task and Finish Group was set up in 2021 to review the Council's residents' permit parking policy. The group were asked to consider and recommend any changes deemed appropriate, that included a consultation exercise carried out with affected residents. As a result of the findings of the group, a revised policy has been approved by Cabinet. The main change approved by cabinet related to the maximum times of operation, which were revised from Monday to Saturday 8am - 6pm to Monday to Saturday 8am - 8pm. It was also agreed that as each resident's parking scheme is reviewed under the new Policy, residents living in the affected areas would be given the opportunity to share their views before any final decision is made about its implementation.

To assist the Council in developing the proposals for the Ystrad Mynach resident parking scheme, a consultation letter was sent out to 273 households living in the following streets, which were within the existing resident parking permit area, to seek the views of the residents:

- Bedwlwyn Street
- Beech embankment
- Central Street
- Church Street
- Commercial Street
- Lewis Street
- Lisburn Road
- Twyn Road

The consultation took the form of a letter and survey asking the resident whether they agreed or disagreed with the current scheme and requested their views on the proposal of increasing the operational times. The survey also gave residents the opportunity to make any further comments if they so wished.

As you will be aware a permit identifier in residents parking zones is a unique code or number assigned to a specific group of streets known as a Zone which is reflected on each residential parking permit. This identifier is used to ensure that vehicles only park within their designated Zone and civil parking officers uses these identifiers to ensure compliance with parking regulations. Vehicles without the correct permit identifier for a zone may be ticketed. There are 2 Zones in Ystrad Mynach which are 503 and 510 and the streets associated with each zone according to the traffic order are as follows:

As Twyn Road is the only street not in the town centre, it is considered that the Zones should be changed to the following:
