We recorded more ASB incidents across Ystrad Mynach and Hengoed during the month of March.

Targeted Activity

- Operation Elson was conducted on 11th March 2025 whereby addresses in the Caerphilly and Nelson areas were raided as part of a large scale drugs warrant.
 Phones, drugs, and cash were seized by police across all the addresses with a full investigation currently ongoing.
- Neighbourhood Ward Officers joined our local School Liaison Officer in attending Llancaeach Junior School in Nelson on 27th March, following concerns from residents and teachers about anti-social behaviour in the village. The pupils were given inputs on anti-social behaviour, peer pressure and the consequences of anti-social behaviour.



Engaged Communities

March was another busy month for building and strengthening community relations through engagement and consultation events.

Throughout the month, the team were involved in 83 community engagement events across the Caerphilly North section including Police Surgeries, Council meetings, giving inputs in schools and attending community events. 17 of these events were across the Ystrad Wards.

On 4th March the Neighbourhood Ward Officer attended Ystrad Mynach Primary School with the GoSafe Team. Pupils were given inputs on road safety and the dangers from road users. They also competed in foot races using the speed gun to capture the best times to show the equipment used by the team.

Neighbourhood Ward Officers and Police Community Support Officers also attended the Ystrad Mynach Spring Fair on 29th March to engage with local communities and show a presence throughout the day.
