We continue to take a robust approach to tackling breaches in the change in legislation regarding XL bulldogs. This is in line with our priorities to minimise risk and maximise the safety to the public. These owners will now face enforcement action, ensuring if the dogs are returned, they are microchipped, neutered and muzzled in public spaces in line with the legislation.
